grant that the powers and authorities aforesaid shall be, and the same are hereby vested in the President for the time being of the Legislative Council of Our said Island. And We do hereby require and command all Officers and Ministers, Civil and Military, and all others the Inhabitants of Our said Island and its Dependencies, to be obedient, aiding and assisting unto you, the said Sir Alexander Bannerman, or in the event of your death, incapacity, removal, or absence from Our said Island, to such person or persons as may, under the provisions of this Our Commission, assume and exercise the functions of Our Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Our said Island.

IN WITNESS whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.
