THE RUBBER TREE.

How the Milk Is Treated After the

Plant is Tapped.

Para rubber is obtained from a large tree sixty feet high. The tree are applied to the state of the stat ped in the evening, and the juice is collected on the following morning. A deep horizontal incision is made near the base of the tree, and then from it the base of the free, and then the same a vertical one extending up the trunk, with others at short distances in an oblique direction. Small shallow cups made from elay and dried in the sun made from clay and dried in the sun are placed below the incisions to receive the milk, each cup being attached by sticking a piece of soft clay to the tree and pressing the cup against it. Each tree yields only about six ounces of juice in three days.

To produce the rubber the juice is heated in the following manner: A piece of wood about three feet long, with a flattened clay mold at one end of it, is dipped in the milk, or this is placed over it as evenly as possible.
