On recommendation of the Food Control Board, and under the Provisions of the Food Control Act, 1917, and the War Measures Act, His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to approve the following Regulations regarding the sale of Sugar:—

"From and after this date no individual, firm, partnership or corporation shall sell or deliver to any person in the Dominion more than fifty pounds of sugar, whether in one or more transactions, unless he shall have first obtained a License so to do from the Food Control Board. Such License shall be issued without charge."
