daily accidents and tragedies on the streets are justification for campaign to lessen accidents. Proposal is made by the Canadian National Safety League, and the approval of Ald. Trepanier. The league introduced a resolution from Toronto, which explained the league desired to extend its activities to this city. The Dominion Government has given a subsidy of \$100,000 and more aid is to be asked. Ald. Trepanier stated that not a child should be killed on the streets, and he urged that education should be given by school teachers and in other ways. As a matter of fact, the school children ought a certain amount of safety and those have been of great help in preventing accidents. More done in the schools and in homes in teaching the youngsters that are to be met on the streets, and in climbing fences and on balcony and gallery railings and by other risks. The safety should be continuous, for work is better than play, and it is interest only for the moment. If both young and old, riding foot, exercise reasonable care, the number of accidents is tremendously reduced in Montreal elsewhere. Safety first.
