Newspaper Postage — M. Dorion is to take the matter of internal postage on newspapers in hand, by moving that the House resolve itself into Committee of the Whole for the purpose of considering the propriety of repealing that question of the Post Office Act of this session, relating to inland postage on newspapers published within the Dominion, and providing that such newspapers shall hereafter be transmitted by mail from one part of the Dominion to another, free. The present charge for postage is vexatious. Departmentally, it is expensive. Moreover, it restricts circulation, and to that extent acts as a hindrance to the general educator of the day—the newspaper. The extension of the impost to Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, in which papers have circulated free, has been attended with wide-spread dissatisfaction, and motives of general, as well as of local polity, suggest its abrogation.

Punch sketches Mr. Disraeli as receiving from the House of Commons the present of a birch, as the new head-master—after the manner of Eton. Another of the papers has a cartoon in which he is entering the Royal presence as Vivian Grey, who has been "sent for." SEMINARY FOR LADIES.—A Ladies' Seminary is likely to be established in London. Dean Hellmuth has the matter in hand, and plans of a suitable building have been submitted. There is a probability of the edifice being erected the present year.


