Yellow Jack Cost the South Millions
 Dollars—4 289 Cases Up to Nov.
 New Orleans, Nov. 24.—The

fever epidemic cost New Orleans cash for hospital, quarantine, disinfecting and other expenses, not less than \$250,000, and the whole south \$1,500,000.

Washington, Nov. 24.—According to the last weekly report issued by the surgeon-general of the marine hospital service giving the returns up to the 10th inst. there had then been

during the yellow fever epidemic south a total of 4,289 cases, of 446 had proved fatal. Of the number of cases, 1,847 were from Louisiana, 1,625 from Mississippi, 740 from Alabama, 52 from Tennessee, 16 from Texas, 4 from Illinois.

In Tennessee the fever was confined to Memphis, Ocean Springs, where the epidemic originated, followed 23 cases and 6 deaths. The cases in Kentucky, Illinois and Georgia were confined to refugees. A complete
