

FINANCIAL AND COMMERCIAL

VEGETABLES WERE MUCH IN EVIDENCE

Fair Sized Crowd Attended London Market This Morning.

There was a moderate-sized market this morning, with plenty of vegetables shown. The dry pavilion was somewhat deserted, only about twenty vendors being present, and there was little change in prices. There were about 50 loads of hay offered for sale at a substantial increase in price, the amounts paid varying from \$11 to \$12.50, though the prevailing price was \$12. Straw remained firm in price, though some sold as low as formerly, the lowest price recorded being \$5. Dressed hogs took another jump, selling up to \$9.75, while several sales were reported at \$10, but these could not be verified. Wheat remained firm at the prices prevailing yesterday.

There has been excellent buying of some of the standard shares, although most of the traders seem to be waiting for further developments. There is very little activity in buying in the market today. If the decline is to carry over, the market has there ought to be a good chance to get in on a profit basis.
