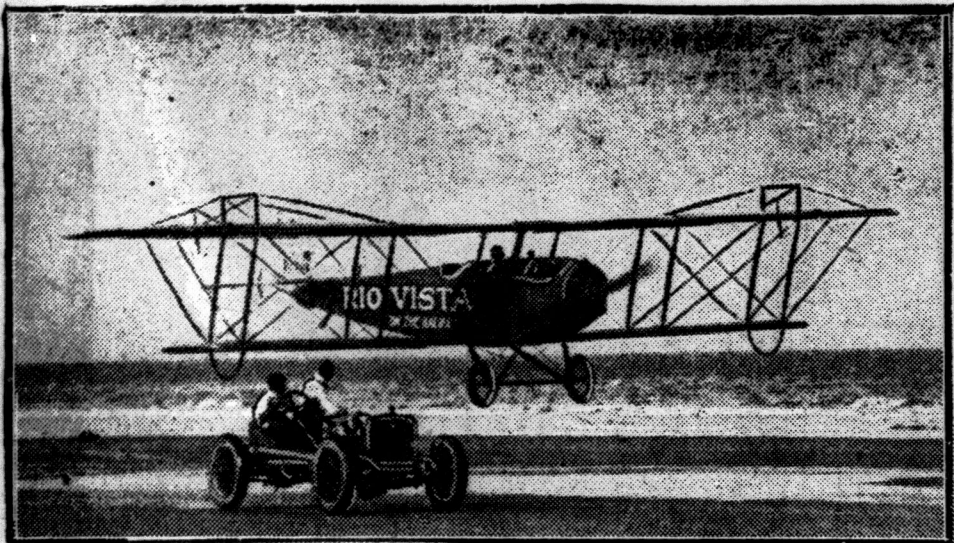

First signs of spring. The ice on the Toronto lake front is already beginning to crack and break up.



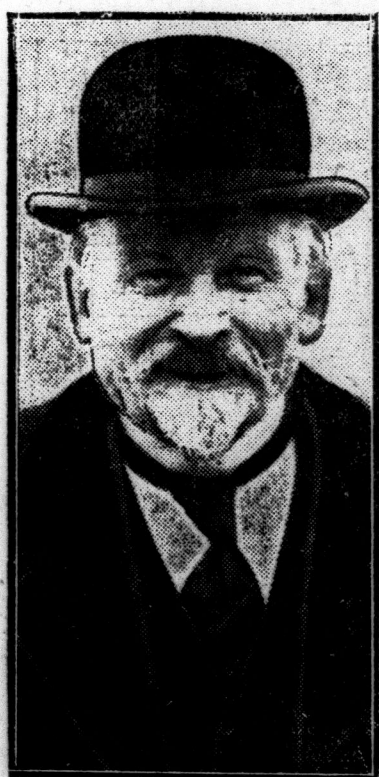

Adelbert Ames, John D. Rockefeller's favorite opponent at golf, who has announced his intention of going after the age record at present held by Methuselah.



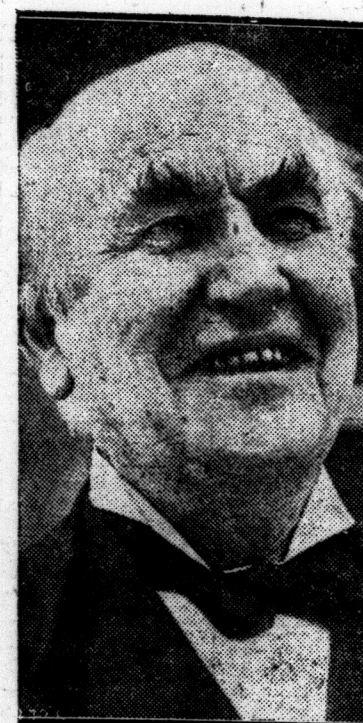
Residents of London are respectfully requested not to put their bombs with the family refuse but to give them to the police.
