LABOR IN ZEALAND

Synopsis of the Interesting Address Recently Delivered by Dr. J. de C. Hathaway.

Progress of the Colony Traced for the Benefit of the Trades and Labor Council.

The following is a condensed report of Dr. Hathaway's interesting address on labor in New Zealand delivered at the regular meeting of the Trades and Labor Council on Wednesday evening last:

The New Zealanders are essentially a British race. There is very little infusion of foreign blood. English, Irish and Scotch become more blended and mingled with each generation. Socially, the New Zealanders are what their forefathers were.

Between 1880 and 1880 efforts were made to encourage the farmer to remain on the land by low rentals, or allowing them to buy the freehold. In 1880 the government has been paid \$138,000 in rent and interest on the land.

Direct taxation has been taken off all improvements and placed on the bare land values. The small farmers are exempted from the tax. The old property tax amounts to \$5,000 a year.
