FIRE ON AN ATLANTIC LINER. Fatal Explosion Followed by Fire on La Normandie. New York, July 14.-La Normandie, arrived from Havre this morning, had a decidedly eventful voyage. Just after her departure from Havre Fireman Francis Lefevre was instructed to open one of the coal bunkers. He did so, using a naked light. As soon as the hatch was opened there was a rush of gas which instantly ignited at the flame, and exploded with tremendous force, instantly killing Lefevre and doing more or less damage to the bunker fittings. Lefevre was a native of Brittany. He was buried at sea.
