The Ambassador of the United States of America to Canada to the Acting Secretary of State for External Affairs

EXCELLENCY,

I have the honor to refer to Your Excellency's Note No. D-277 of December 5, 1952 stating that in view of the common defense interests of Canada and the United States the Government of Canada is prepared to grant to the United States a lease of certain lands situated within the Royal Canadian Air Force Station Goose Bay in the Province of Newfoundland.

The terms set forth in your Note are acceptable to the United States of America. Accordingly, my Government concurs in your proposal that your Note and this reply shall from the date of this Note constitute a lease agreement between our two Governments on this subject.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my most distinguished consideration.
