EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to your Note No. 226 of October 26th, 1970 relating to investments in Barbados which would further the development of economic relations between Barbados and Canada, and to guarantees of such investments by the Government of Canada, through its agent, the Export Development Corporation.

I have the honour to confirm that the arrangements governing the guarantee of Canadian investment in Barbados as contained in your Note meet with the approval of my Government. I therefore agree to your proposal that Your Excellency's Note and this reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments.
