Volunteer Abroad

WHAT IS IT?

Volunteer Abroad is an opportunity for Canadians and youth from all over the world to work together on volunteer community projects in over 20 countries. Volunteers benefit from the experience of living and working with other volunteers as part of an international group whose energy is devoted to providing a useful service, while also gaining a greater knowledge and understanding of the world.

Canadians can volunteer for camps in: Belgium, the Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Hungary, the Netherlands, Poland, the Slovak Republic, Spain, the United States and the United Kingdom.

Camps are designated as social (working with children), environmental (manual work in parks, nature protection), archaeological (volunteering on digs), renovation (renovating historic sites and buildings) and agricultural.

HOW LONG CAN I STAY?

Depending on the country, the duration varies from a minimum of one week to a maximum of three weeks during the months of June, July, August and September.

WHO CAN APPLY?

To be eligible, applicants must:

- be at least 18 years of age.
- be willing to work on a volunteer basis.

How Do I APPLY?

A registration fee of \$150 must accompany the application which is due by March 15 of each year. Participants are responsible for arranging their own transportation, visas and insurance. (All travel arrangements must be made through Travel Cuts/Voyages Campus, a travel company wholly owned by the Canadian Federation of Students.)
