## ARTICLE V

The Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria guarantees that payments will be made on the due dates in accordance with the terms of payment in Article III.

## ARTICLE VI

The Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria shall not divert to another country any wheat purchased under these arrangements without obtaining prior approval from Canada.

## ARTICLE VII

The Government of Canada and the Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria agree that the concessional sale of wheat pursuant to this Agreement should not disrupt normal trade in this commodity. To this end the Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria undertakes to:

- (a) ensure that deliveries of Canadian wheat pursuant to this Agreement are additional to commercial purchases for cash, or credit on terms of three years or less, from all sources, of at least 500,000 metric tons of wheat per year.
- (b) ensure that there is no export of wheat from Algeria during the period of delivery, and twelve months following the last delivery made under this Agreement without prior consultation with the Government of Canada.

## ARTICLE VIII

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature.
