Island, in the southeast part of the Belcher Archipelago. Ultra-Shawkey
Mines Limited has carried on exploration of iron-bearing deposits on Baffin
Island.

The increasing tempo of exploration activity which has characterized the Canadian iron ore during the post World War II years has continued into the year 1957. Undoubtedly some of this activity will culminate in major mine development programs similar to those now underway. Much of the credit for this continued growth of the iron ore industry lies with those beneficial Canadian features - abundant resources, geography, and a favourable political and legislative climate.
