

- Second Committee - Questions connected with the work of Technical Organizations, i.e., Economic and Financial Questions; Communications and Transit Questions; Health Questions.
- Third Committee - Questions connected with the reduction and limitation of armaments. (This Committee was not set up in 1933 as the Conference for the reduction and Limitation of Armaments was in session). Nor does it seem probable that the Committee will be set up this year.
- Fourth Committee - Budgetary and Administrative Questions.
- Fifth Committee - Social Questions, i.e., Penal and Penitentiary Questions; Protection and Welfare of Children and Young People; Traffic in Opium and Other Dangerous Drugs, etc.
- Sixth Committee - Political Questions, i.e., Protection of Minorities; Mandates; Slavery; Intellectual Cooperation, etc.

The appointment of delegates to the various Committees will depend to some extent on the final allocation of the items on the Agenda. It is a question for decision by the senior delegate.

The Chairmen of the main Committees are elected by the Assembly and, with the six Vice-Presidents also elected by the Assembly, form the General Committee of the Assembly. This General Committee is responsible for assisting the President
