

3. HEALTH UNIT

The Health Unit is located in the main lobby adjacent to the Tower C elevator lobby. Their phone number is 996-9227. It is staffed by qualified Health and Welfare Canada Occupational Health nurses and the Unit's hours of operation are 08:00 to 16:00 regular working days only.

During those times that the Unit is closed, employees may seek assistance from the Building Control Centre located on the ground level of Tower B (992-1150).

4. FIRST-AID STATIONS AND ATTENDANTS

In compliance with the regulations defined in Treasury Board Manual, Canada Labour Code Part II and Part XVI of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations, each department and agency is responsible to provide first-aid services to employees during established hours of work.

A 24 hours manned first-aid station is located in ISRG at the Building Control Centre, ground level of Tower B. In addition, during the course of the regular working day, trained, certified first-aid attendants are present throughout the building and are prepared to render assistance when called upon.

5.. MOBILITY IMPAIRED PERSONS

Special Assistance During Evacuations

The Chief Building Emergency Officer maintains a register of persons requiring assistance during an emergency evacuation. The information is deemed "**PROTECTED**" and serves only those who have a legitimate need to know. Special assistance may be required for:

- a) permanent disabilities such as blindness, mobility impairment, etc.;
- b) medical conditions such as cardiopulmonary disorders, spinal problems, etc.;
- c) temporary physical conditions such as broken limbs, pregnancy, etc.

Employees requiring evacuation assistance must **self identify** with their respective Floor Fire Emergency Officer. They should provide:

- a) name;
- b) floor and location;
- c) type and duration of condition; and
- d) type of assistance required to evacuate the building.
