THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT A STEERIAL MEETING OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC COUNCIL WILL BE HELD IN PARTS COMMENCING TUESDAY, DECEMBER 11, PRECEDED BY A MEETING OF THE MILITARY COMMITTEE ON DECEMBER 5, AND A JOINT MEETING OF THE MILITARY COMMITTEE AND THE PERMANENT COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 7.
