Mr. McInnes was born in London, England on February 18, 1912, and studied at the University of Melbourne, and in Europe. He was Art Editor of Saturday Night from 1935 to 1940, and lectured in art at the University of Toronto, Extension Department from 1938 to 1941. From 1946 to 1948 he was a Senior Producer and Coordinator of Graphics with the National Film Board. After joining the Department of External Affairs in 1948, Mr. McInnes served as First Secretary in New Delhi 1952 - 1954, and as First Secretary, and later Counsellor in Wellington, 1954 - 1955. He was appointed Chief of Protocol in Ottawa in 1957. After attending the Imperial Defence College in 1958, Mr. McInnes was appointed as Counsellor and later as Minister in London in 1959, and as Canadian High Commissioner to Jamaica in 1962. He is the author of A Short History of Canadian Art, Lost Island, The Road to Gundagai, and Sushila; and has had articles published in Canadian Art.
