PRAYERS.

Bill C-202, An Act to prevent pollution of areas of the arctic waters adjacent to the mainland and islands of the Canadian arctic, as reported, from the Standing Committee on Indian Affairs and Northern Development (with an amendment), was again considered at the report stage.

By unanimous consent, motion numbered (2), standing in the name of the honourable Member for Oxford (Mr. Nesbitt), as follows:

That Bill C-202, An Act to prevent the pollution of areas of the arctic waters adjacent to the mainland and islands of the Canadian arctic, be amended by adding thereto, immediately after clause 27 thereof, page 23, the following:

“Savings

28. Nothing in this Act shall in any way be construed to be inconsistent with Canada's rightful claim of sovereignty in and over the water, ice and land areas of the Arctic regions between the degrees of longitude 60 and longitude 141.”

and by renumbering clause 28 of the Bill, page 23, as Clause 29.

was withdrawn.
