

The Clerk read the title of the Bill to be assented to, as follows:—

An Act to provide for the Resumption of Operations of Railways and for the Settlement of the Existing Dispute with respect to Terms and Conditions of Employment between Railway Companies and their Employees.

To this Bill the Royal Assent was pronounced by the Clerk of the Senate in the following words:—

“In His Majesty’s name, the Honourable the Deputy Governor General doth assent to this Bill.”

After which the Honourable the Deputy Governor General was pleased to retire.
