social institutions, philosophy, religions, literature and art in a series of lectures complete in two academic years of three hours per week. All materials are drawn from Chinese sources and interpreted from the Chinese viewpoint. Language classes are open for elementary and advanced students, with instruction in both the written and spoken forms. Chinese readers in Euo Yu or the Mandarin language are used, with well selected characters, and helped in pronunciation by the new phonetic keys and the Wade spelling system. Writing Chinese with the brush is also taught in class.
