A postal settlement in the Dominion Electoral district of Yale-Kootenai and Provincial of West Kootenai 28 miles from Nakusp. The principal industry of the place is mining. Nearest telegraph, express office and banking point, Nelson. There are two general stores, and one clothing store, and three hotels, but no churches or schools; mails once a week; communication by passenger trains and boat, also by stage every four days to Nelson, and every five days to Nakusp. Population about 50.
