size, their plots will be kept level, mowed and cared for for all time in the future.

¶ This Perpetual Care Fund is kept separately invested in Government Bonds or equally good securities. The interest ONLY therefrom is used for the future care of said plots.

¶ It is therefore cheaper in the end than paying for annual care, besides making sure of your plot being looked after when YOU and your CHILDREN have passed to the Great Beyond.

¶ As a rule the third generation will take but very little interest in the care of or keeping up the appearance of YOUR plot, as our otherwise beautiful Cemetery already bears testimony in the number of plots lacking any care whatever.

¶ Then why not take a Perpetual Care at once? If you keep putting it off, it's possible some one else will have to do it for you, if it is ever done at all.
