Lord Chancellor and the Judges of the Courts of Westminster-Hall.

Such are the prayers and intreaties of your Petitioners, the loyal and affectionate subjects of Great-Britain, residing in the province of Quebeck; that, from the wisdom, the justice, and the bounty of the Crown and Parliament, they may obtain to this province a constitution and government, a quietude and prosperity, that may call from the present people and age their unceasing acknowledgements and gratitude, and make the future inhabitants of it seel, (as may the present) that the only means of happiness to the people and province of Quebeck is a union and submission to the Crown and the Government of Great-Britain.
