FRENCH CANADA'S WANTS  
According to a Startling Story in The Toledo Bee of Yesterday.

THE PRESIDENTS OF CONFIDENTIAL UNION  
Hold a Gathering in Toronto Toward the Close of This Month Which will be "Practically Sanctioned by the Government," Says the Writer.

TOLEDO, O., Sept. 12.—The Bee today contains a special letter, signed "A. Regnault," headed "A Convention in Toronto," "Annexation Party" and "Powerful and Growing Force—The French-Canadians the Prime Movers in the Work to Abolish English Rule." The letter reads:

Toward the close of this month a convention of Canadian annexationists is to be held in Toronto. Under ordinary circumstances this announcement would attract but little attention, even in the Dominion, for among the Conservative Government and the work of the so-called Confidential Union Associations has been pretty thoroughly suppressed, even in the Conservative press.

This year the Liberals are in authority. Wilfrid Laurier, the first French-Canadian to attain the Premiership, is at heart the staunchest of Annexationists, and so for the first time in the history of Canada the promoters of Confidential Union will hold a gathering, practically sanctioned by the Government.

With each recurring national election in the United States the question of annexation seems to come to the surface on the other side of the line. Here, except among the 500,000 French-Canadians in New England, there is no intense popular feeling on the question, and yet it is steadily opening in Canadian Liberal circles that the "sinews of war" come from the United States.

In fact, the French-Canadians mentioned, and there are those who openly assert that Canadian annexation to the United States has long been its firmest and most avowed friends in the person of Andrew Carnegie.

What he has in mind is not a cause, if anything, is not known to the public on this side of the St. Lawrence. Nor is he the only American interested in this movement. For the past two years emissaries of Confidential Union have been employed traveling through the United States, inquiring into the possibilities of annexation, and building up a secret annexation organization which is to work in conjunction with the Canadian States.
