

## COMPETITORS' MEETING.

The President explained that this meeting was held so that an opportunity should be afforded the competitors to express their views on all matters relating to the matches, and, if they thought it desirable, to pass resolutions of recommendation touching any of these matters.

On motion of Mr. J. Hunter and Col. Beer (upon which there was discussion and explanations), it was resolved

That the Council be recommended to erect a separate butt for the Extra Series Matches.

It was resolved, on motion of Lieut. Manning and Private C. T. Burns,

That the Council be recommended to insert a 600-yard Snider Extra Match in next year's programme.

Moved by Col. Beer, seconded by Private C. T. Burns,

That in the opinion of this meeting it would be desirable for the Dominion Rifle Association to adopt the Martini-Henri as the sole rifle for their matches, and that the Government should issue a sufficient number of Martini rifles to the Militia to supply the riflemen of Canada.  
—Carried unanimously.

Moved by Capt. Kinnear, seconded by Major J. J. Tucker,

That, in future, members of the Active Militia compete in all matches of the Association in uniform.—Carried.
