


Ottawa, March 21.—The House of Commons this afternoon passed a resolution, moved by Premier King, approving of the run-running treaty concluded between the United States and Great Britain. Premier King asked Parliament to approve the treaty on the ground of morality, international good-will and commercial benefit.

The Canadian Government, said the Premier, had approved the treaty subject to approval by the Canadian Parliament and had asked that where a board was appointed to consider the question of compensation to a Canadian vessel, the representatives of the Empire on board should be nominated by Canada. To this the British Government had agreed.

Premier King read a synopsis of the agreement, which gives to the contracting parties the right to extend the right of search and seizure, hitherto confined to a three-mile limit, to a distance approximating one hour's journey from the coast. The speed of the suspect vessel itself is to be considered in adjudging what distance an hour's journey would be. A board would be established to con-
