We observe that an interesting ques-tion of precedence has come up in the Montreal Methodist conference which is now in session at Ottawa. Dr. Douglas of Montreal introduced a resolution com-demning the present table on the ground that it gives archbishops and bishops precedence after the lieutenant governors of Ontario, Quebec, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick and before members of the cabinet. The resolution of Dr. Douglas, which was carried after an exciting de-bate, declares rightfully enough that the constitution of Canada knows nothing of the union of hurch and state, recognizing all sections of the Church as standing on the ground of equality.
