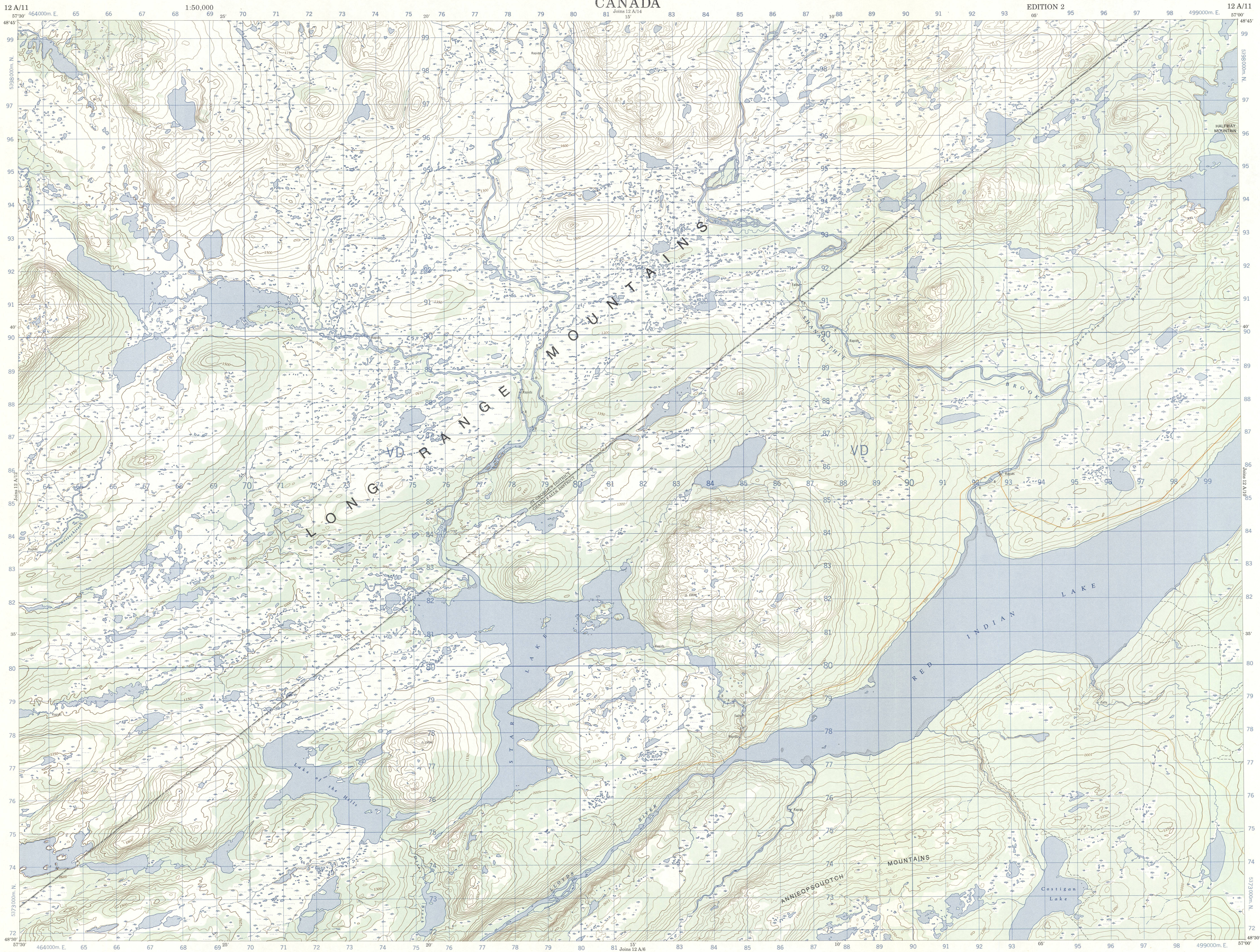

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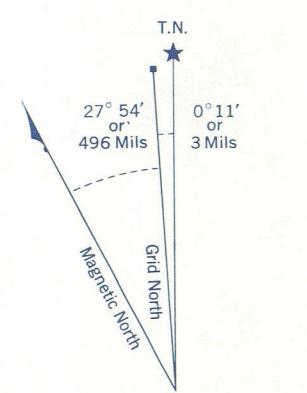
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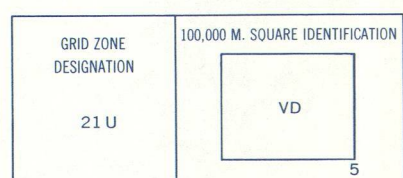

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING ARE NEAREST 100 METRES ONLY
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP

REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (as above)
EASTING: Road number on grid line immediately to left of point	97
Estimate tenths of a square from this line toward to point	97.5
NORTHING: Road number on grid line immediately below point	98
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	98.4

EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE: 975884
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 62 miles)
