Leaving Montreal by Notre Dame St. East over good macadam roads, past Lepine Park to Bout de l'Isle, the most eastern point on the island. Here turn north, passing the rapids over rather poor roads to Sault au Recollet; thence south and west over clay roads to St. Annes. Fair road from St. Annes to Beaconsfield and good macadam in to Montreal.

Montreal to Terrebonne, 15 miles.

Leave Montreal by St. Lawrence St. to Sault au Recollet. Cross Back River by the bridge (toll 5c.) thence east along the bank to Terrebonne, crossing another bridge when near the village (another 5c. for toll at this bridge.) Good macadam roads all the way.
