PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the Common Council held in the City of St. John, Monday, the 15th day of July, instant.

WHEREAS it is desirable to discontinue that portion of the north-eastern end of Nelson Street, on the West Side of the Harbor, in the City of St. John, described as follows, that is to say: All that portion of Nelson Street, West in Guys Ward, in the City of St. John, on the western side of the Harbor which lies North of a line described as follows: beginning on the Eastern side line of Nelson Street at the intersection thereof with the line of division between "B" and lot sixteen (16); the said point of intersection being at a distance of Two hundred and seventy-eight (278) feet, more or less, measured along the said line of said Street from the intersection thereof with the northern line of Cross Street, as shown on the plan of Fort Neck prepared by Thomas Kelcey, and bearing date September 18th A. D. 1855, the said plan being on file in the office of the Common Council of the City of St. John, rolling thence Northwesterly in a direction at right angles to the said Street thirty (30) feet or to the western side line of Nelson street.

THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the portion of Street above described, and the same is hereby discontinued.

NOW THEREFORE NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that after the lapse of THIRTY days from the first publication of this Notice and after the continuous publication of the same as by Law required in the last meeting of the Common Council held after said lapse of Thirty days after such publication, it is the intention of Alderman Agar to move the above Resolution for so discontinuing such portion of said Street and that such Resolution will be moved at such meeting.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND STIPENDS

Any person who is the sole head of a family and who has been a resident of a quarter section of available Dominion land in the Northwest for one year prior to the date of application may apply to the Department of the Interior for a stipend.

Stipends are payable to the holder of a quarter section of available Dominion land in the Northwest on a farm of at least 30 acres, or to the holder of a half section of available Dominion land on a farm of at least 60 acres, or to the holder of a full section of available Dominion land on a farm of at least 120 acres.
