EXTRACT FROM P.C. 1053, DATED JUNE 29, 1922—Provided that a report shall be made by every Department to the Civil Service Commission in the months of January, April, July and October in each year, setting out the name, duties, salary, place of residence, and place of employment of each person appointed under the authority of these Regulations during the preceding three months, with the date of commencing duty and the probable duration of employment. In each case where the employee has been on military service overseas, the letters "O.A.S." should be added after the name.
