4 Geo. 4 . . . 26	An Act to authorize the Chairman and Trustees of the Common of the Seignior of La Baie St. Antoine, commonly called La Baie du Fèbvre, to terminate certain disputes relating to the limits of the said Common, and for other purposes appertaining to the same. This Act amends and extends the Act of Lower Canada, 2 Geo. 4, cap. 10, and both are continued by 27, 28 Vict., cap. 24, to . . .	1st Jan., 1865, &c.
9 Geo. 4 . . . 32	An Act to alter and amend an Act passed in the sixth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act to authorize the Inhabitants of the Fief <i>Grosbois</i> , in the County of "St. Maurice, to make regulations for the Commons of "the said Fief." This Act amends Geo. 4, cap. 10, and both are continued by 27, 28 Vict., cap. 24, to . . .	1st Jan., 1865, &c.
