The Hon. Paul Hellyer, Minister of National Defence in the past Pearson Cabinet addresses the student body today in Mc-Connell Hall between 12:30 and 1:00. A graduate of the University of Toronto in 1949, he was elected to the House of Commons at the age of 25 to become Canada's youngest House Member.
