Sir.

Reference your letters of August 4", 1915, No. 360260, re
road diversion through portion of Pasqua Indian.
Reserve required by Grand Trunk Pacific Railway
Company. In reply I beg to say I would value this
land at Twenty Dollars per acre, or a total of
\$32.00 for the 1.60 acres required.

My reason for not closing up this matter
earlier is that it has been impossible so far to
get a majority of the Indians together without
taking them from their haying or cutting crops.
The Indians are spread over Pasqua and Muscowpetung
reserves haying.

From your letter of August 31", I take it that the valuation of this land is the principal consideration. I will, therefore, inform the Indians of the whole matter, at the first opportunity.

If this is not satisfactory, and you will advise me. I will call a meeting of the Band immediately on your instructions.
