Sir,

Reference your letters of August 4th, 1915, No. 360260, and August 31st, 1915, No. 360260, re road diversion through portion of Pasqua Indian Reserve required by Grand Trunk Pacific Railway Company. In reply I beg to say I would value this land at Twenty Dollars per acre, or a total of \$32.00 for the 1.60 acres required.

My reason for not closing up this matter earlier is that it has been impossible so far to get a majority of the Indians together without taking them from their haying or cutting crops. The Indians are spread over Pasqua and Muscowpetung reserves haying.

From your letter of August 31st, I take it that the valuation of this land is the principal consideration. I will, therefore, inform the Indians of the whole matter, at the first opportunity.

If this is not satisfactory, and you will advise me, I will call a meeting of the Band immediately on your instructions.

I return blue-print herewith as instructed.
