Dear Mr. Meighen: Re: Section 215, The Criminal Code

We are very glad to learn that a compromise has been agreed upon with respect to sub-section 3, of the amendment to section 215, of The Criminal Code, which passed the House of Commons, being Bill 71.

The proviso which is being added to sub-section 3, may not be very harmful. At any rate the Children's Aid Societies are prepared to accept the section in the form as agreed upon in the hope that it may very materially remove the difficulties with which they have been confronted in securing convictions and in protecting unfortunate children brought up amidst poverty and crime.
