

My Government believes that, by giving honourable expression at the proper moment to the foregoing considerations, it is discharging its duty to the countries Members of the League, and adhering to the principles by which its foreign policy is guided; for it clearly realises that, within the machinery that governs the activity of the organs of the League, it is not in a position - nor, of course, does it claim - to go further than stating its attitude on a question of such gravity, which will so profoundly influence international life in the future.
