The above increases are required to build up present units to minimum peace strength, and will make it possible to maintain the following units.

- No. 1 Fighter Squadron, (at approximately 2/3 war strength) to be stationed at Calgary.
- No. 2 Army Co-Operation Squadron, (at approximately 2/3 war strength) which it is proposed to move to Ottawa.
- No. 3 Bomber Squadron, (at approximately 1/3 war strength) presently stationed at Trenton.
- No. 4 Flying Boat Squadron, (at approximately 2/3 war strength) at Vancouver.
- No. 5 Coastal Reconnaissance Squadron, (at approximately 2/3 war strength) at Dartmouth.
- No. 6 Torpedo Bomber Squadron, (at approximately 2/3 war strength) being organized at Trenton, and to be moved to Vancouver Island.
