

(b) Equipment, Fd Arty

- (i) Directors, No. 7C - One of the two pilot models has been shipped to UK, by air, 3 Dec. Arrangements have been made for the second director to be taken to CMHQ by an officer proceeding overseas by air.
- (ii) Dial Sights - A further quantity of substandard No. 9 Dial Sights will be accepted for trg purposes and for use at practice firings. This makes a total of sixty of these instruments to be accepted.
