Α. Between 4 & 5 cell blocks. There was quite a number of staff there at that time. Q. Where were you standing? In line? I was standing so I could look along the front of the A. Q. Was the accused alone? Α. There was a number of SUS there but he did come down off the parade square and he went into the cell. Q. Shere was he when you first saw him? A. On the parade square. He was less than 100 feet away from me. I didn't see him until he came off the parade Q. Whereabouts did he come off the parade square? Just in front of #6 cell block. A. He would be 50 feet away from you? Q. A . Yes, Sir. Q. Were there other SUS around him? A . Yes, Sir. Q. Did you recognize any of the other SUS? Α. No, Sir. Were you looking particularly for the accused? No, Sir. Why I noticed him was that he was out of my hut. Q. A. Q. Are you swearing on oath that he was the only one out of your hut? your hut? No, Sir, I wouldn't swear to that. He was the only one that I saw out of my hut There could have been more than him but I didn't see them. A . Q. Where was he in relation to the other SUS? Three or four feet away from them. Α. Q. In the middle of the group? There were other SUS around him. A . Were there other SUS between you and the accused? Q. Α. They were moving back and forwards. Q. You say you saw them going into the cell block? Yes. Sir. A . Did you actually see them go in? Q. A . Yes, I stepped along and watched . Did you see any of the staff attempt to stop them? They were there before we got there. Q. A . Q. Did any of the staff try to stop them? Α. I couldn't say. G. Which end of the cell block is the entrance door? The right hand side facing the living huts Is it the east or west end of the cell block? West side. How wide would you say the cell block was? I don't know, Sir Approximate idea? I didn't look in the cell block, Sir.
