TORONTO, the First City in Canada, in a commercial way, with a population of two hundred and seventy-five thousand; two hundred and seventy miles of streets, paving mostly asphalt and brick; two hundred and fourteen churches of all denominations.

Annual revenue from waterworks, \$550,000.00, water always fresh, cold and good. Water pumped every twenty-four hours during 1902, nearly 25,000,000 gallons.

Estimated value of property owned by City \$9,000,000.

Total assessment of property in the City, \$150,995,595.

Area of land within the City limits, not including land covered by water, nineteen miles.
