Deputies and Commissioners: Salaries ranging from \$5,000 to \$4,000	8%
Technical Assistants: Salaries ranging from \$4,000 to \$1,000	25.4%
Secretaries: Salaries ranging from \$3,500 to \$1,500	17%
Clerks and Accountants: Salaries ranging from \$2,500 to \$1,000	18.3%
Junior Clerks and Messengers: Salaries ranging from \$1,000 to \$700	26%
Stenographers: Salaries ranging from \$1,050 to \$600	25.3%
Permanent House Staff: Salaries ranging from \$2,125 to \$1,150	42.8%
Temporary House Staff: Wages ranging from \$624 to \$1,873	52.4%
