The Directors in closing the affairs of the Hospital for another year, would be speak on behalf of the sick and afflicted, liberal contributions from its friends,—hitherto the want of funds has prevented expenditure for other requirements than of maintenance, but in the future, sums hitherto applied to the building fund will be required to effect repairs and further improvements, which are now wanted to keep the Hospital in a proper state of preservation and efficiency.

They trust that those kind friends who have assisted them during the past year, will join them in thankfulness to God that so much in the way of aid and comfort to the afflicted has been accomplished, and that the prospects of the early freedom of the property from debt are so cheering.
