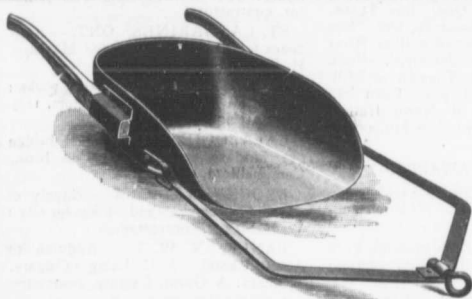

street and Logan avenue. This will be replaced later in the season by a stone and brick structure.—The new building to be erected here by Miller & Richard, type-founders, Toronto, will be a five-storey building, of modern construction.

TORONTO, ONT.—Darling & Pearson, architects, have prepared plans for an office building to be built at St. John, N.B., by the Canadian Bank of Commerce.—The Merchants' Dying & Finishing Co. and Garside & White, wholesale shoe dealers, purpose erecting warehouses on York street near Front.—Arrangements have been completed for the rebuilding of the two large six-storey buildings at 52-54 Wellington street west owned by Cowan Co. and Pugsley, Dingman & Co.—The Wyld-Darling Co. have announced their intention of rebuilding their warehouse as soon as possible.

—The Eckardt Casket Co. have had plans prepared for a new four-storey building, 196 x 80 feet, of brick and steel, with a two-storey dry kiln building 80 x 40 feet.—The McClary Manufacturing Co., of London, will erect a new warehouse on a site within the burned district.—The Featherbone Co. have purchased the lot at the north-east corner of Duncan and King streets on which to build a new factory.—It is understood that the Pure Gold Manufacturing Co. purpose erecting a new factory and warehouse, their present premises, corner King and Duncan streets, having been purchased by the E. W. Gillett Co.—The extensive lot on the corner of Dundas street and Howard Park ave. is understood to have been sold for immediate building purposes.—The McLaughlin Milling Co. will likely rebuild on their former site at corner of Bay St. and the Esplanade.—The City Council have authorized the preparation of plans for a new pavilion in the Allan Gardens, to cost \$60,000.—The Assessment Commissioner has been requested to report on a new site for the Bay street fire hall. A clock will be purchased for Bolton Ave. fire hall at a cost of \$2,500.—The City Engineer has recommended the septic tank system of sewage disposal for the Island, at an estimated cost of \$54,000.—Chief Thompson, of the Fire Department, has made the following recommendations: The erection of a fire station in the vicinity of York and Wellington streets; repairs to Yonge street engine, \$1,800; purchase of two 1,200 gallon engines, \$12,600; two large hose wagons, \$1,400; 2,000 feet 3-inch fire hose, \$3,000; 2,000 feet of 2½-inch
