BARCELONA, Mar. 8.—The city is being extensively decorated and no official efforts will be spared to give King Alfonso a creditable and enthusiastic reception on his arrival here on Tuesday. Nevertheless, the greatest concern being felt for the king's safety, owing to the activity of the Catalan revolutionists and anarchists, who recently have created almost a reign of terror in this city. There has been five bomb explosions here since January 1, and not a single culprit has been caught. Only a few days ago placards were posted throughout Barcelona that an attempt would be made upon the life of the king should he carry out his determination of visiting this city. The placards were torn down by the police, but the fear that an outrage will be attempted, remains. General Linarez, who was in command of the Spanish forces at Santiago, and who was captain-general of Catalonia, will be in supreme command of the military arrangements and with Inspector Arrow, late of Scotland Yard, and now chief of police here, he is taking every precaution to insure the safety of the king, who will be his personal guest. In addition to the close guards will line the routes wherever the king goes, practically all the civil guards in Spain, except detachments in Andalusia, are concentrated here and eight battalions have been specially drafted for this service. Secret instructions have been issued to the police to search all persons wearing Spanish papers under which, as was the case in the Lisbon tragedy, arms might be concealed.'
