Deaths from natural causes of the week ending March 17th, 1939.

Mr. Martin Pennock, who has been visiting relatives and friends at Elgin, left on Monday last for his home in East Oakton, Ont.

The birthdays of Miss Edna Fair and Master Beaumont Cornell were celebrated last week, and a large number of the little ones highly enjoyed the events.

Mr. F. H. Eaton, a highly successful teacher, has accepted a position at that of Brockville Business College and expects to remove his family from Athens in about three weeks.

A protest has been entered against the return of Geo. E. Graham for the Brockville riding. The usual charges are made, in addition to personal charges, and the seat is claimed for Mr. Colburn.
