Competition Potato The Prizes Are

1st, \$16.00; 2nd, \$14.00; 3rd, \$12.00; 4th, \$10.00, 5th, \$8.00; 6th \$6.00; 7th, \$5.00, 8th, \$4.00.

The Competitions will all be of a dual nature: Field and Bin Inspected.

In order that a county or one or more counties grouped, as in the case of the Potato growing Competitions, may qualify for one or more of the competitions, there must be at least 15 entries for the particular crop or crops in which the farmers wish to compete.

The prizes will not be paid until after the judges have submitted their report on the bin inspection. A prize will not be awarded in any case, no matter what the field score, unless the required quantity, wheat, 30 bushels; oats, 100 bushels; potatoes 100 bushels has been cleaned or graded in read iness for the judges' bin inspection in case of potatoes before December 1st. 1924 and in the case of grain before February 15th, 1925.

Entries in the potato competition close positively on June 20th. Entries in the grain competition close on July 15th. Please note these dates now. The entry fee is 25c per crop which must be paid at the time of making entry.
