Fry brown on both sides and serve on a hot dish.

A large quantity is best kept in a well-corked can provided with a faucet an inch or two from the bottom, so that the oil can be drawn off as required without disturbing the sediment which usually collects on the bottom of the vessel. If either cork be left out for a day or two, the oil will burn dull and cake on the wick, especially if the kerosene is kept in a warm place.
